FARMER'S MARKET VENDOR* | 9 AM TO 12 PM

We welcome most types of vendors, including small businesses (i.e. arts & crafts, produce, baked goods, specialty foods, retail, clothing & accessories, non-profit, etc.) Registration ensures an approx. 10 x 10 space. We are unable to provide a canopy, table or chairs, so please feel free to bring your own. Set-up may start as early as 8 a.m. and you are welcome to stay for the whole day. In order to participate, we ask that vendors give a \$25 donation to our First Responders Fund.

FOOD VENDOR* | 10 AM TO 6 PM

Food vendors are welcome to sell their food items all day. Vendors will need to follow proper procedures set forth by the Health Department, as well as contact the Health Department on their own. In order to participate, we ask that vendors give a \$50 donation to our First Responders Fund.

KIDDIE PARADE | 10 AM

Kids (ages 3-12) are welcome to join this fun patriotic bike/ride-on parade on Saturday morning. Coordinated and judged by the Swayzee Public Library, kids will get to be in their own parade around the West Park track for family members and friends! All kids will receive a goody bag. Prizes will go to the top three most patriotic displays, with 1st place winning a brand NEW BIKE! The winners are welcome to participate in the Town parade (per parental supervision).
